


Cross Stitch Pattern

Face with Stuck-Out Tongue and Tightly-Closed Eyes

Cara sacando la lengua y ojos cerrados • kidding, not serious

A face with tightly-close (boomerang) eyes, open mouth and tongue sticking out. Just silly and undoubtedly friendly.



Full Cross Stitch

Work in rows from left to right. Bring the needle up at point 1, lower left hole of one square of the fabric and down at point 2, upper right hole of one square of the fabric. Bring your needle back up at 3 down at 4, up at 5 down at 6. Complete the row. The return row is stitched right to left, make crosses by bringing the needle up at 9 and down at 10, up at 11 down at 12. Complete the return row and repeat the stitching sequence until the area is stitched as charted.
