



Cross Stitch Pattern




Full Cross Stitch

Work in rows from left to right. Bring the needle up at point 1, lower left hole of one square of the fabric and down at point 2, upper right hole of one square of the fabric. Bring your needle back up at 3 down at 4, up at 5 down at 6. Complete the row. The return row is stitched right to left, make crosses by bringing the needle up at 9 and down at 10, up at 11 down at 12. Complete the return row and repeat the stitching sequence until the area is stitched as charted.

Back Stitch

A line on your design indicates a back stitch. Work from right to left. Bring your needle up at 1 and back down at 2. Move left and bring needle up at 3 and back down at 1. Continue the sequence. When there is a back stitch over a cross stitch, form the cross stitch first.
